

KISAR May 16, 2019 General Meeting Minutes

Call to order at 7:01 PM at Bayside Firehall

Guests: Jamie Greendyk introduced herself and expressed an interest in joining KISAR.

April General Meeting minutes read and approved.

No treasurer's report. No non-profit update.

Nick indicated that the Southern Regional EMS grant is more complicated than we thought. It was decided to ask for \$2,000. S.R.EMS will pay \$1.5k of that and KISAR will contribute 25% and will need a 15% community match. Nick will set up a meeting with Siene Allen to clarify the rules of the grant.

No ASARA updates- Nick was not able to make the last meeting. Need to turn in receipts for Deb by end of June. No more ASARA training funds after June 30. ASARA will pay for Paul A's airfare.

KISAR should discuss grant funding opportunities and in-house training options.

Paul Anderson will be in Kodiak July 5 to "train the trainers" and July 6-7 to train all active members. Everyone is responsible for their own Initial Response and Incident Command (IRIC) manuals and Nick will email out the PDF.

Ian thanked Steven and Philip for going to Dutch on the recovery mission.

It was discussed what the membership would like Deb to cover in the upcoming training. A refresher/overview, and scenarios were identified as priorities.
